After much bad mouthing from me...I bought a Trex 250! I had a conversation about them during the FF with my buddy Mark from the U.K. He raved and raved about his. So, I had some money to burn and a desire to build...I saw the Super Combo on the Amain hobbies website for \$375 (after discounts). I'm really impressed with this little bird! It's just the right size for my backyard. Despite the many posts I've read online; mine is really stable right out of the box. It's bone stock with the plastic blades and supplied tail servo.

I don't find it twitchy or exceedingly hard to fly in fact mine files pretty good. It's really light so I have to go really easy on the collective or it becomes a yo-yo. I'm flying it with the 16T pinion and outrage 860mah packs and it's got plenty of power. I get around 4-5mins depending on how hard I push it. I've put around 80 flights on it so far (real easy when you're flying in the garage and backyard) I'm very happy with it.
