It's now summer, or more like monsoon season. With the heat at the field we all need to remember to drink plenty and wear sun block. Everyone is there to have some fun and we really don't want anyone to experience heat stroke first hand. I bring this up because recently we had an older gentleman at the field that combined with other conditions was seriously affected by the heat. And by that, several of us got to see how long it took the fire department to respond (there is one less than a mile away). Luckily everything turned out o.k., but it definitely brought home what could happen. We are currently out of fuel. I have been pricing fuel from our regular source, but the shipping has gone up to the point where we could make a bulk purchase locally for the same price. Either way the pricing is looking at \$25/gallon for the 30% cool power. Another option is to purchase Magnum 30% which would come in at less than \$23/gallon (it is actually bottled in 1.25 gallon bottles). I have no personal experience with this fuel, so I would like some feedback as cool power has always been the standard by which everything else is compared with.

Lastly, I have mentioned to some of the guys that the people who do our event shirts can do an embroidered shirt with the cactus logo and the ARMS names. I think they would be pretty nice, but that's me. We can basically get anything embroidered as I have had a request for a wind breaker. I need some feedback on this also as I would like to get an order together. That's it for this issue.













































Notes from the Editor
